Government of Ontario	One-Time Childcare Payment	A one-time payment of \$200 dollars per child of up to 12 years of age, and \$250 dollars per child with special needs.
Government of Ontario	Job-Protected Leave	The Employment Standards Code now allows employees to take 14 days of leave if they are required to self-isolate or caring for a dependent that is required to self-isolate.
